Occasional Care

Occasional Care is a service we provide to families whose children are enrolled in the YMCA School-Age Care program. It is care on an irregular basis outside of the regular enrollment. Occasional Care is not available at all sites and times. Payment must be made in advance. Participants must receive prior approval from program staff to confirm space is available.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Program Registration	Prior to attending the program, each child must enroll in School-Age Care. The enrollment process consists of completing the online pre-enrollment registration and completion of the WA State required Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS). At least two full business days are required to process the registration before enrollment is finalized at which time attendance is permitted.
Registration Fee	All care options require a \$50 non-refundable registration fee per child, per school year.
Monthly Fees	Monthly fees are created by taking the total days of care, from the first day of school to the last day of school, and dividing by 10 months. Spreading the cost equally across the 10 months of the school year.
Scheduled shut-down days	Scheduled shut-down days, holidays, and possible emergency closure days have been taken into consideration when planning fee schedules. Pro-rating and refunds will not be issued for closure days. This practice also applies to additional care hours/days that may arise due to school calendar changes made after fees have been set.
Non-school and Break days	Additional "mini" registrations are required for non-school days and school breaks for all participants. Registration for all non-school and break days open approximately 2 weeks prior and close the Wednesday prior to care.
Occasional Care	Occasional Care is a service we provide to families whose children are enrolled in the YMCA School-Age Care program. It is care on an irregular basis outside of the regular enrollment. Occasional Care is not available at all sites and times. Payment must be made in advance. Participants must receive prior approval from program staff to confirm space is available.
Withdrawals & Changes	A 15-day written notice is required for all withdrawals or changes in care to be eligible for credit or refund if eligible. Please submit a School-Age Care Change Form to provide this notice. For withdrawals for changes to full day child care on non-school and break days, a School-Age Care Change Form is required two business days prior to the first full day of care.
Membership	A YMCA Youth membership is included with enrollment in one of our School-Age care plans for the duration of the current year's enrollment, September to June. Participants who register for the following school year during priority registration in the spring will maintain their child's membership year-round. Families who withdraw from enrollment will have the option to continue their membership at the regular price.

PAYMENT OPTIONS & DISCOUNTS

Monthly Payments	All school-age care tuition is due by the 25 th of the month prior to receiving care. Methods of accepted payment are Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, personal check, money order, bank draft, or cash (please do not send cash in the mail). Automatic draft is our preferred payment method. Families have the option to pay in full on the 25 th of each month prior to care or split their payments in two on the 10 th and 25 th of the month prior to care. Failure of parent/guardian to pay monthly fees will result in removal from care.
Sibling Discount	A discount of 10% is given to families with more than one child enrolled in care. The discount is applied to the eldest child in care.
Active Military / School District Discount	A parent/guardian that is Active Military or a School District employee in the State of Washington will be given a 20% discount. If you currently receive Financial Assistance (AFA), we are only able to offer the military/district discount OR financial assistance. If your scholarship amount is higher than 20%, you will remain on scholarship.
Financial Assistance	The Y is for everyone. Please contact your local YMCA branch to inquire about financial assistance to help support the cost of care. We invite you to submit an Access For All Form online or at your local Y.
Subsidy for Child Care	Our School-Age programs are licensed by Washington State DCYF (Dept of Children, Youth, and Families) and accept state subsidy for child care. Co-pays are due by the 25 th of month prior to care. If authorization is not received, the registering adult will be responsible for the full cost of care. SSPS numbers are available on our website, at your local YMCA facility and in our Family Handbook.
