FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE & SLIDING SCALE RATES

The YMCA of Snohomish County believes every child should have access to safe, enriching before and after-school care. To support families, we offer Sliding Scale monthly rates. Eligible families may receive reduced tuition for Before and After-School Care. Sliding scale fees are determined by:

- Household income
- Household size
- Demonstrated financial need

How to apply for Financial Assistance:

1. Complete the [Financial Assistance Worksheet](#) online or at your local YMCA.
2. Submit required income documentation when requested by YMCA staff.
3. YMCA staff will review your application and notify you of your monthly rate.

Once approved, the adjusted tuition amount will be applied to your child's care plan for the school year.

Applications are accepted year-round.

DISCOUNTS

Sibling Discount: 10% off eldest child

Active Military Discount: 20% off

School District Employee Discount: 20% off

COMBINING DISCOUNTS

Families receiving financial assistance are not eligible to combine with military or school district employee discounts. The YMCA will ensure families receive the best available rate option.

WASHINGTON STATE CHILD CARE SUBSIDY

Our Before and After-School Care programs are licensed through the Washington State Department of Children, Youth & Families (DCYF) and accept Working Connections Child Care (WCCC) subsidy.

How to apply for child care subsidy:

- Families can apply by contacting the Child Care Subsidy Contact Center at 1-844-626-8687 or online at www.WashingtonConnection.org
- DCYF gathers and reviews information to determine a family's eligibility.
- Families will need to provide DCYF with the name and phone number of the child care provider. You do not have to have a provider before applying for child care subsidy.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Membership	A YMCA Youth membership is included with enrollment in one of our Before and After-School care plans for the duration of the current year's enrollment, September to June. Participants who register for the following school year during priority registration in the spring will maintain their child's membership year-round. Families who withdraw from enrollment will have the option to continue their membership at the regular price.
Program Registration	Prior to attending the program, each child must enroll in Before and After-School Care. The enrollment process consists of completing the online pre-enrollment registration and completion of the WA State required Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS). At least two full business days are required to process the registration before enrollment is finalized at which time attendance is permitted.
Registration Fee	All care options require a \$50 non-refundable registration fee per child, per school year.
Monthly Fees	Monthly fees are created by taking the total days of care, from the first day of school to the last day of school, and dividing by 10 months. Spreading the cost equally across the 10 months of the school year.
Scheduled Shut-down Days	Scheduled shut-down days, holidays, and possible emergency closure days have been taken into consideration when planning fee schedules. Pro-rating and refunds will not be issued for closure days. This practice also applies to additional care hours/days that may arise due to school calendar changes made after fees have been set.
Non-school and Break days	Additional "mini" registrations are required for non-school days and school breaks for all participants. Registration for all non-school and break days open approximately 2 weeks prior and close the Wednesday prior to care.
Occasional Care	Occasional Care is a service we provide to families whose children are enrolled in the Before and After-School Care program. It is care on an irregular basis outside of the regular enrollment. Occasional Care is not available at all sites and times. Payment must be made in advance. Participants must receive prior approval from program staff to confirm space is available.
Withdrawals & Changes	A 15-day written notice is required for all withdrawals or changes in care to be eligible for credit or refund if eligible. Please submit a Before and After-School Care Change Form to provide this notice. For changes to full day child care on non-school and break days, a Before and After-School Care Change Form is required two business days prior to the first full day of care.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Monthly Payments	<p>All tuition is due by the 25th of the month prior to receiving care. Methods of accepted payment are Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, personal check, money order, bank draft, or cash (please do not send cash in the mail).</p> <p>Automatic draft is our preferred payment method. Families have the option to pay in full on the 25th of each month prior to care or split their payments in two on the 10th and 25th of the month prior to care. Failure of parent/guardian to pay monthly fees will result in removal from care.</p>
Third Party Pay	The YMCA accepts third-party payments, including state subsidies, employer benefits, MCCYN, and other authorized agencies. Families are responsible for any portion of tuition not covered, including copays or gaps in funding. If third-party payments are delayed, reduced, or end, families are responsible for keeping their account current.
Subsidy for Child Care	<p>Co-pays are due by the 25th of month prior to care.</p> <p>Families are responsible for adhering to DCYF policies and processes for maintaining and renewing eligibility for WCCC subsidies. If authorization is not received, the registering adult will be responsible for the full cost of care.</p>
