

Everett Miller's Y Story

In 1961, Everett "EV" Miller came to the Everett Y as general secretary after leading the YMCA in Minot, North Dakota. For the next 20 years, Miller served as the Y's chief executive, providing steady leadership and a vision that helped shape the organization for generations to come.

Miller was especially respected for his work with adults and for his leadership throughout the Everett community. He served on the Everett Park Board, was active in the Everett Rotary Club and First Methodist Church, and remained deeply committed to strengthening the community he called home. When he retired in 1981, Miller had served longer as the Everett Y's chief executive than anyone in the association's history.
